



We provide free assistance to fire victims by providing limited lodging, clothing replacement, food, and a warm hug.



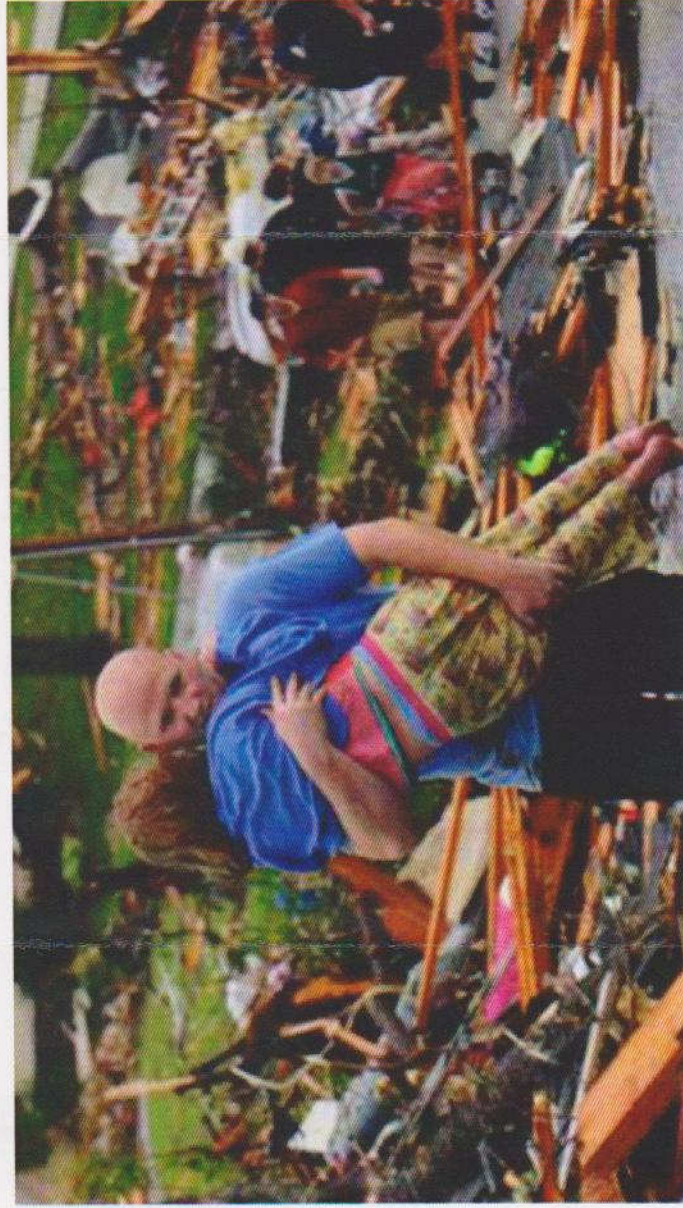
Emergency evacuations occur when you least expect it. We offer a safe place for residents during chemical disasters.

Northwest Tennessee Disaster Services is a state chartered 501(c)(3) Humanitarian Relief organization.

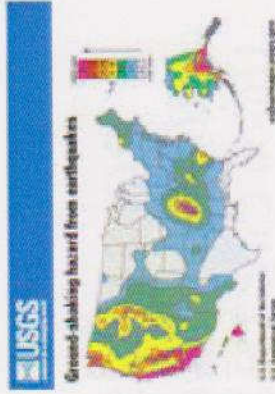
As a team of community volunteers, we work with national, state and local officials to serve Obion, Weakley, and Lake counties in times of disaster.

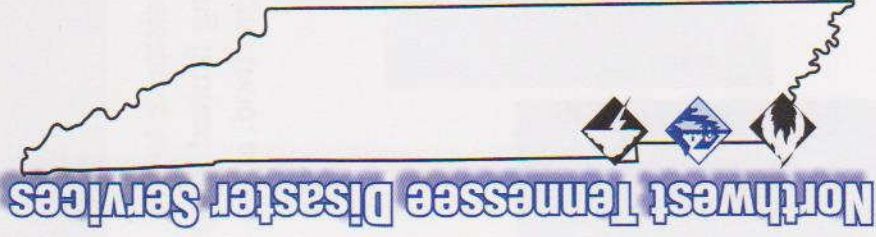


Mission Statement
